FAQs (Frequently Asked Questions)

Question: What are the dates of the camps?

Answer: Camp dates vary and occur between June and August. We will know specific dates in March and April of 2008 and we will do our best to work around your summer plans.

Question: How long and where do we stay?

Answer: Camps normally run 5-7 days, some as long as three weeks. Some are residential camps and others are day camps, so you may be camping out or going “home” each night to a B&B, hotel or host family.

Question: Do I get to choose the camp?

Answer: We ask teachers to select their first, second and third choice and we do our best to pair teachers with their choices. Much is dependent upon the teacher’s dates of availability and the camps’ dates.

Question: Does this credit satisfy the Alaska Studies or multi-cultural studies requirements for new teachers?

Answer: Yes, this course satisfies both the Alaska Studies (ED 541), 3 credits and the Multicultural Studies for Alaska’s Teachers: Rural Communication and Culture (ED 555B), 3 credits

Question: Can my spouse and I travel together to the same camp?

Answer: If spouses are both selected to participate, they will be sent to different camps.

Question: Can elementary school teachers participate?

Answer: Yes, but space is limited to four Anchorage-area Title I schools at this time.
